

EERA Summer School 2016 on "Methods and Methodology in Educational Research"



11 – 15 July 2016
Linz, Austria



EERA and the Johannes Kepler University of Linz are pleased to announce the 2016 EERA Summer School which will be held at the Johannes Kepler University of Linz, Austria, from 11 - 15 July 2016.

We invite 70 European doctoral research students to a five-day Summer School focusing on the role of „Methods and Methodology in Educational Research“. The Summer School will be held at the Department of Education and Psychology.

The summer school aims to:

- open and promote a European research space for collaboration and networking between early career educational researchers
- explore the opportunities and challenges available through different analysis approaches in educational research projects
- introduce and examine critically new ways of thinking about the structure of the 'data' we often analyse in educational research and consider these in relation to participants' current and future research projects

The Summer School will offer:

Morning sessions with stimulating lectures on various educational research topics with experienced professors as well as opportunities to discuss and develop your own research project in collaboration with other research students and experienced tutors, a varied and engaging social programme and a visit to BIFIE (Federal Institute for Educational Research, Innovation & Development of the Austrian School System) and the city of Salzburg.

The five day course will be a mixture of lectures, workshops and peer group discussions. Students will be advised and supervised by experienced researchers. ECT credits will be appointed, 3.0 (with paper)/1.5 (without paper). Students are required to hand in a short paper in advance, a template will be provided.

Who can attend?

Applicants normally come from or study in EERA member countries. Their theses must relate to educational research. The Summer School will be held in English. There is no tuition fee, but participants must cover their travel costs and make a contribution of 270,- € for students from High GDP countries or 180,- € for students from Low GDP countries, respectively. Accommodation costs in Linz will be covered. Participants will be expected to share a double room with a same-sex participant. Breakfast and lunch will be provided every day, plus a welcome and a farewell dinner. There will be options for other social activities (e.g. a visit to the Museum of the Future).
